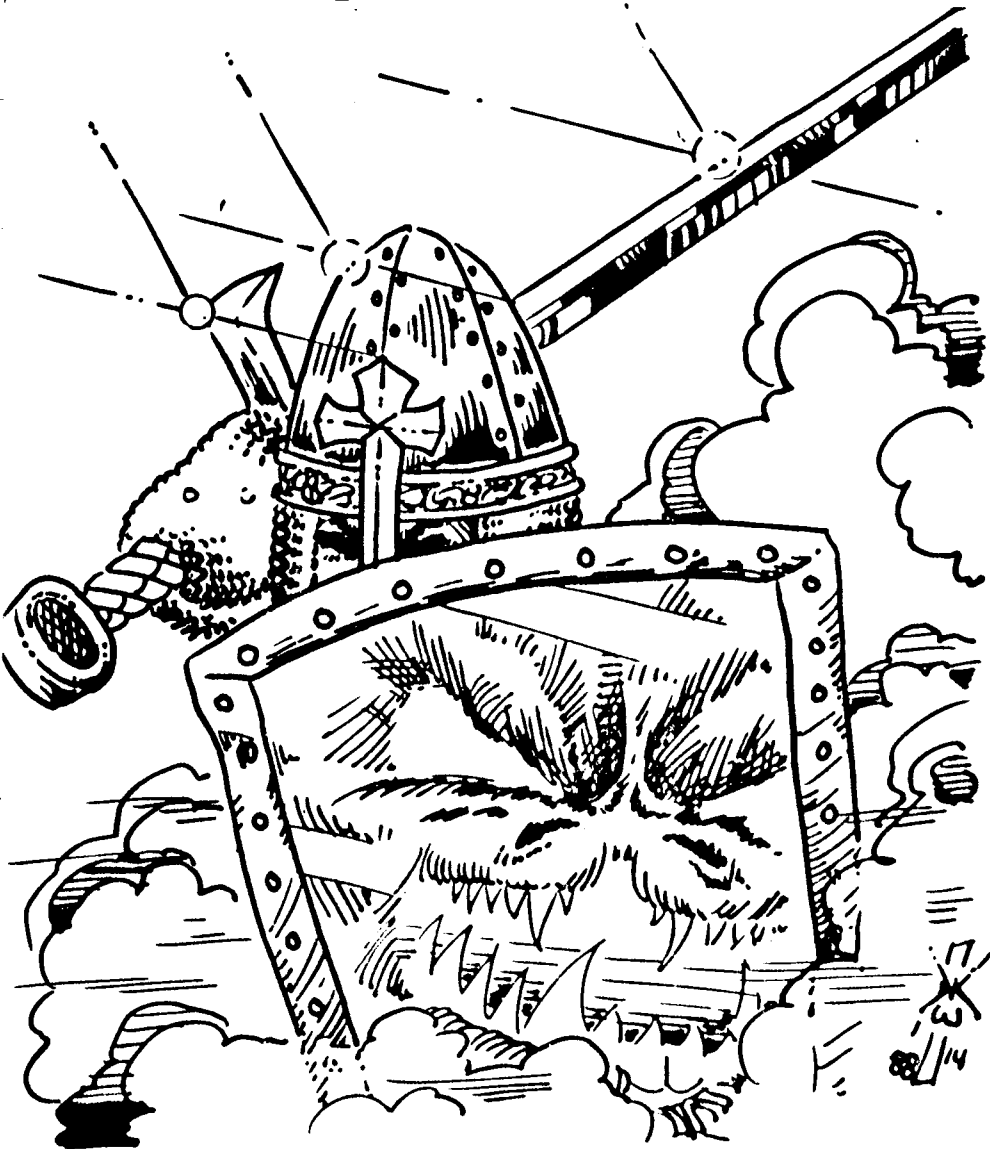

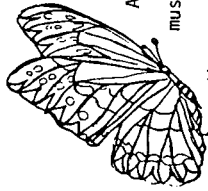
The Moose will be Loose in April or so I am told. For details contact Lady Olivia. We will have more information in the next Moose Call.

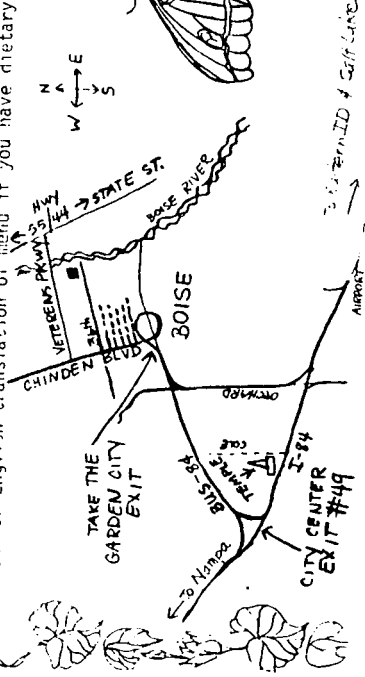
