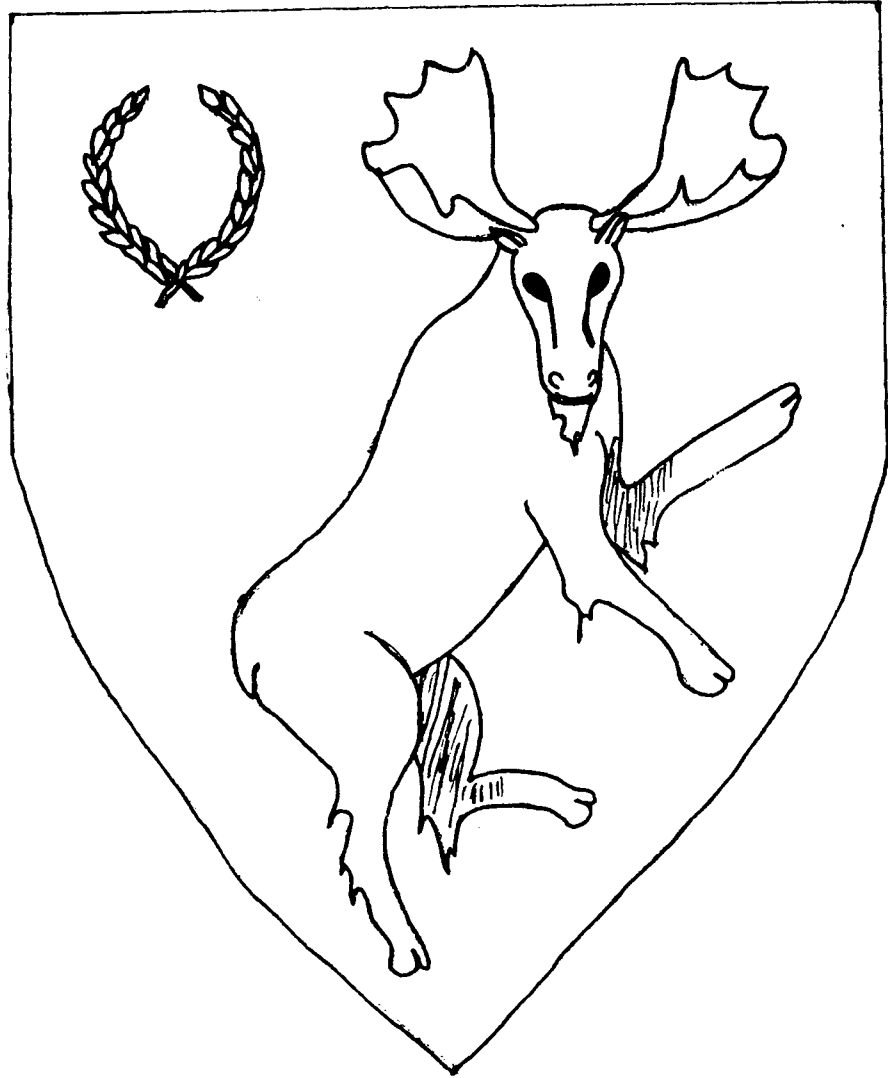
Activities include the list, a masked ball, a fundraiser, and the wedding of Georg and Natalia.
