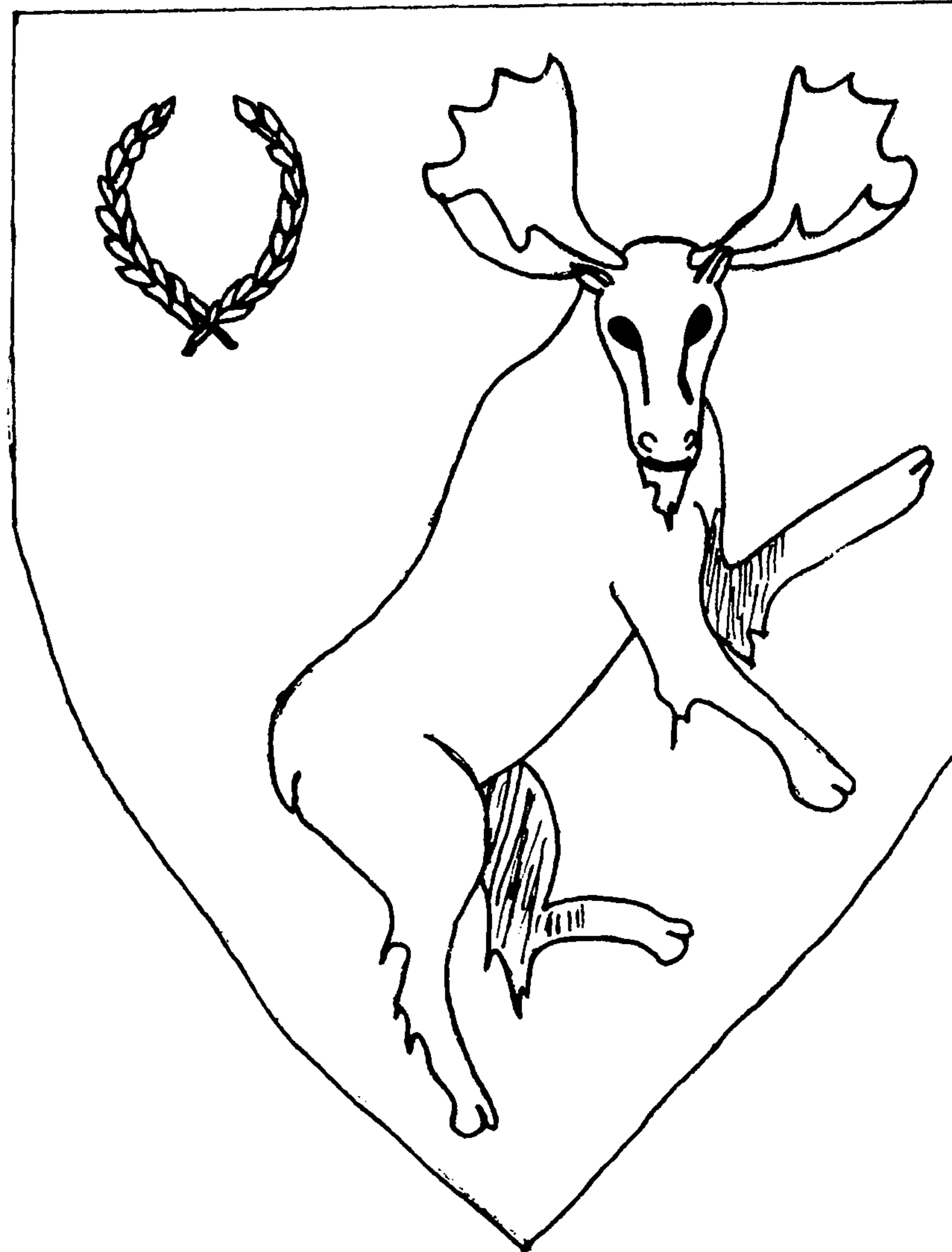

"HER?? YOU CAN HAVE HER. SHE DOES ALL HER WORK WRONG TO SPITE ME."

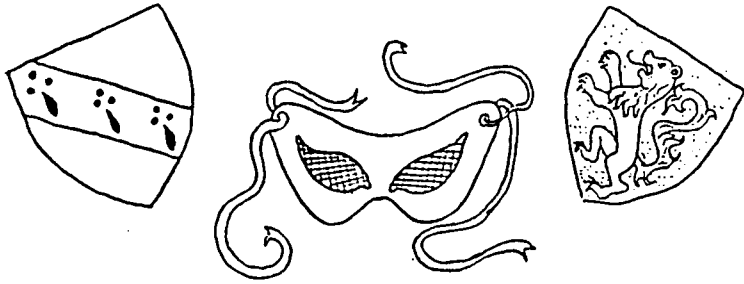
"Fine. Just let her down and I'll give her a horse so she can ride home."

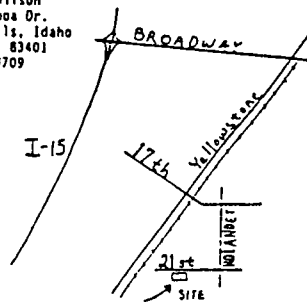



On November 12 the Shire of Arn Hold will be hosting the Artemesian Arts and Science Competition. It will be held at the YWCA, 720 W. Washington, Boise, Idaho. This is a wet site. Site fees are \$3.00 for members and \$4.00 for non-members. There is also a \$0.50 per item entry fee.

To find the YWCA take the Broadway exit in Boise. Follow Broadway north to Idaho Street. Go one block west on Idaho and turn right on 1st Street for 3 blocks to State Street. Turn left on State and follow it to 8th Street. Turn right on 8th and go one block to Washington. The YWCA is at the corner of Washington and 8th. Turn right on Washington and the parking lot is on the left side just past the building. Parking is limited.

This competition will be run in accordance with Kingdom rules. The Atenveldt Arts and Sciences Criteria Booklet is available from Lady Jocelyn Douglas Fairfax for \$4.00 (payable to Kingdom of Atenveldt), c/o Josi Ingram, 2936 N. 30th Street #4, Phoenix, Az 85016. The booklet is designed to help you prepare your entries to show well, and to give to give them a better chance to win.

Entries can be registered for competition either by mail or at the door. The site will open at 7:00 am Saturday morning. Registration closes at 9:00 am. Judges are needed. If you are interested in judging please contact Lady Joanna de Paladin at (208)365-2939, or Lady Els Merryweather (Sue Gawron) at (208)342-1385 evenings or (208)343-1022 days.

There will be a feast on Saturday evening. The feast fee will be \$5.00. The menu will be:

- bread, cheese and herb butter
- French onion soup

- spinach tarts
- cucumber sallet and olives
- beef dijon
- mushroom pasties
- pears in wine sauce
- honeyed ham and fruit
