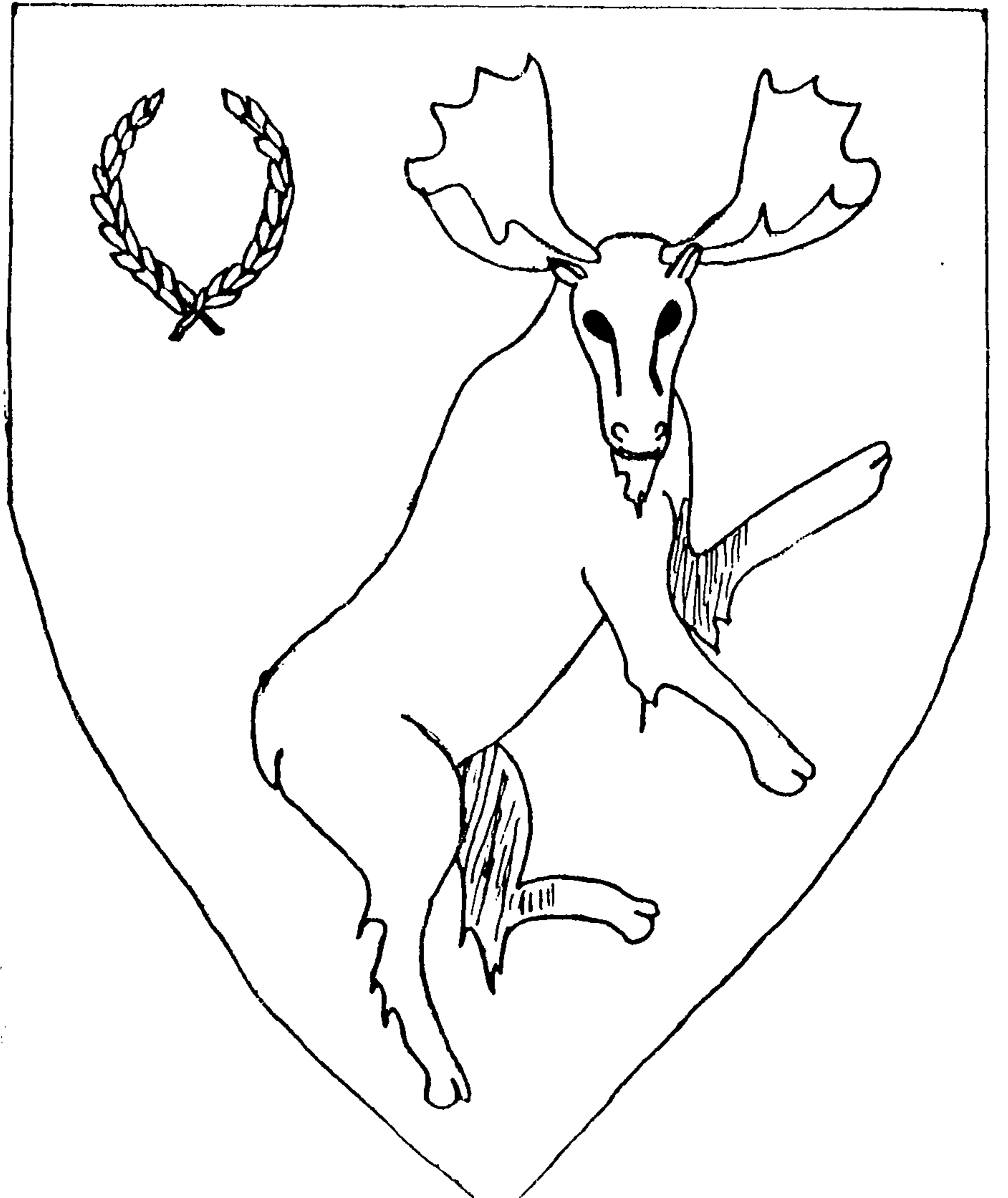

# Castle Kitchen

## Rouladen

Take raw beef sliced thin and spread with seasonings: mustard, salt, pepper, onions, pickles, bacon. (Use any combination). Roll up and secure with skewers. Roll in flour and sauté lightly. Add chopped onions to frying pan and continue sautéing. Add water to cover, simmer gently 2-3 hours.

## Spätzle

3 1/4 cups flour  
3 eggs  
1 c. water  
pinch of salt

Mix until dough is smooth and glossy. Roll out and slice, drop into boiling water. Boil gently uncovered until spätzle are firm. Remove with slotted spoon, rinse and drain well.

# demo news

Greetings fellow Messengers of the Moose! I, Lord Einendloch, your Co-ordinator of things demonstrative, offer these words concerning some of the Demos of the past, and of those yet to come.

I would like to thank all of those who assisted with and/or attended the many demos we have had recently. Based on the nature and the flurry of request received, I feel I know what it is like to be under seige.

We were well received and perceived by the 200+ women of the Junior League at the demo January 16th, held at the Boise Senior Center. A brief stage presentation and multiple table display attracted the interest of many. We have received an invitation to participate in the League's RenFaire which will be held later this year.

January was "Knights in Armor" month for the Cub Scouts of Canyon County. The Intrepid Troopers of Arn Hold conducted three demos, January 24th in Kuna, January 25th and 31st in the Nampa area, for these boys in blue. Our demos drew many elementary adjectives, and the appreciation and thanks of several Scout Leaders.

In February, the pace slackened abit, having but one demo, for a Home Teachers group in the Caldwell area. The group recently has been studying the Middle ages and it showed. Both parents and children were knowledgeable and very interested, so interested that a demo scheduled for one hour lasted three! One enjoyable aspect of this demo was being greeted at the door by children in garb!

Earlier this month, if my soothsayer is worth his salt, we attended, at the request of its organizers, the First Annual Social Sciences and Public Affairs Conference at the Student Union Building on the BSU campus. Exactly what we did, and how well it went escapes me at the moment, but ask me a simple question concerning it and I shall be most happy to tell: you what you missed.

In the demos we have had to date, not including the March 3rd thing, we have presented our era before approximately 400 people. This is good exposure for both the SCA and Arn Hold. Your continued support of these demos is sought, and will be appreciated.

Stolen soles of the past (video tapes) were used occasionally during the demos we have held thus far. They have helped in augmenting our presentations. Plans are in the works for refining two tapes, one less than 15 minutes in length, and another, longer. Another effort being considered is a tape of Arn Hold's Best, doing whatever it is they do.
