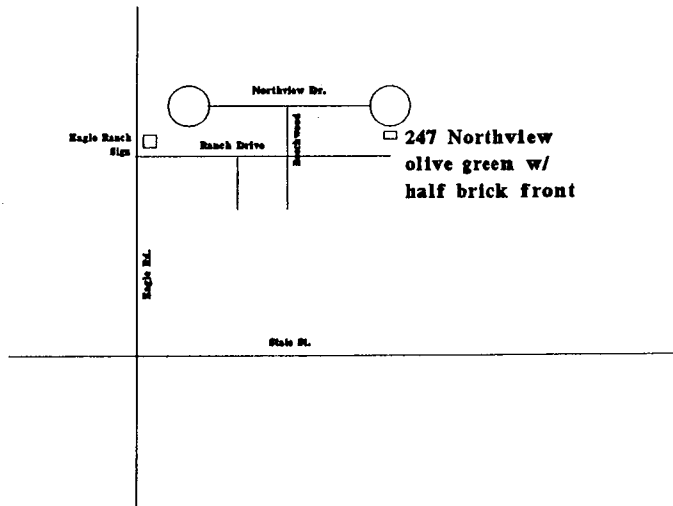

The Shire of Arn Hold has been asked to participate in the FIRST Renaissance Festival to take place here in Boise! The Event is being sponsored by the Junior League of Boise, and promises to be pretty spectacular!

It will be held June 10th and 11th, 1989 at the Old Penitentiary. Hours on Saturday are from 10am to 8pm. Hours on Sunday are from 12pm to 6pm. The Junior League has graciously granted us our own compound area with space for both static display and fighter demo.

Participation in this event is broken down into three categories:

- Fighting/Street Scenarios
- Static Display/Compound Demos
- Wandering to provide atmosphere

Each participant will be expected to spend no less than three hours committed to compound shifts. Fighters should see Lord Brendan for sign-up and scenario description. Non-fighters should see Lady Els for sign-up of shifts in the compound area and commitment on items they can provide for display. The minimum number of people we need to pull this off is 12 non-fighters and 5 fighters. **THIS MEANS WE NEED YOU!!!!**

You must sign-up prior to the event! The Junior League's program must go to press on 5/10, so we must have your name for the list at the May meeting, if possible. If your name does not appear on the list, you will not be permitted to gain free admission to the fairsite. Costume is mandatory. Proof of membership may be required at the Faire gates.

On a related topic, the Junior League has expressed an interest in having our people dance at the Faire. For those of you who haven't tried it yet, or may need to brush up on what we did so long ago, Lady Olivia/Caitlin and m'lady Renate have organized a Dance Workshop between 10am and 3pm on Saturday, May 20, 1989.
