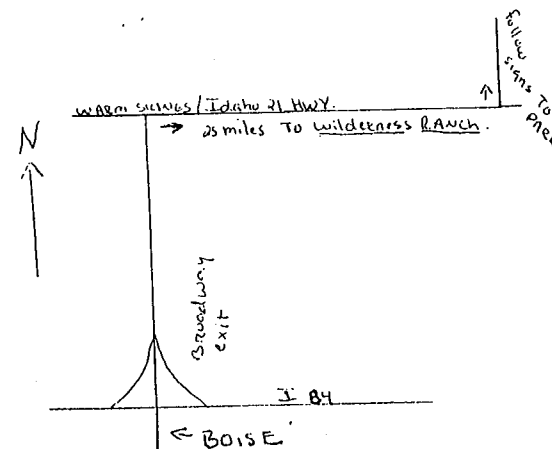

Greetings Unto the Known World, the Shire of Arn Hold wishes to announce that its Arts and Science Competition will be held on Sunday, July 23. We will be awarding Champion, First, Second and Third place scrolls. A Champion must enter three or more categories. We will then take the average score of each entrant, if they have entered three or more categories, to find our Champion. First, Second and Third places will be awarded based on the average score of each entrant. Principality judging sheets will be used for the judging.

The competition will be held at Vertrans Memorial Park on 36th and State Street. The site will open at 11:00 am for set up and registration. Site fee is \$2.00 for non-members and \$1.00 for members, smalls under 12 will be charged 1/2 of the adult fee. Please have your membership card with you when you pay or you will be charged the non-member fee. A 25¢ fee will be charged for each entry. Please make all checks payable to the "Shire of Arn Hold, SCA, Inc."

Games will be available to play and the river is a short walk for those who wish to refresh themselves in the cool waters. We will also do some dancing if the great Ateneveldt sun is merciful to us. HOW SCORES WILL BE DETERMINED

The judges will be the entrants of each category. This means that each entrant will be judging his or her own work as well as those of the other entrants in the category. If there is less than three entrants in a category, judged will be selected that have not entered the category so that there will be at least three judges per category, (the entrant will be judging also, for example: if there is one entrant in a category we will be seeking two more judges, if there is two entrants than we will only need one more person to judge.) We will be averaging the scores of each entry (item entered) to get the total score for that item. The entry scores for each entrant will then be averaged together to give that person their total score for the competition. We will then award the First, Second and Third place scrolls to the people with the highest average points. So even if you have entered only one item you still have a chance to get first place in the competition. We will also be awarding scrolls to those placing first in each category, this score will be on the individual entries, not a combined average score. The Champion Scroll will be awarded to the person with the highest average score of those people who have entered three or more Categories.

I hope all of you will try and enter at least one item.
