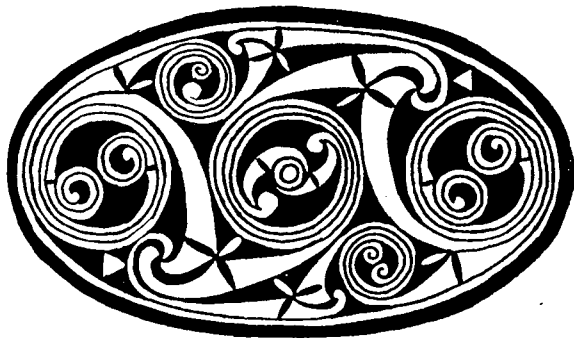
The Continuing Adventures of The Souse Bound Norseman

Seneschale's Report

The Mountain Home area populace has filed for canton status. The Board of Directors is in the process of implementing a \$3.00 surcharge to all site fees for non-members. The extra fee is to be sent to the corporate office within 7-10 days of the event, and the new fee goes into effect June 1. The BOD is also implementing an insurance waiver to be signed by all people on-site whenever fighting takes place, with all children under 18 having a parent or guardian sign the waiver. This is also to be sent to the corporate office asap after the event.

Crown Tourney received press coverage from local television station channel 7. The seneschale reminded officers that all publicity needs to be cleared through the PR deputy, herself and the baron and baroness.

Officer Reports

Knight Marshall-The barony needs to purchase more rattan. Fighter practice attendance is picking up with better weather; new fighters include Cunar, Lore and James.

Rapier Marshall-There will be a Rapier Champion for Artemisia chosen by tournament at Uprising, June 17-18 in Thousand Eyes.

Herald-Kelwin announced she will be taking over as acting Goldenwing Herald at Uprising and she will be submitting a bid to become Goldenwing permanently. Purpur Pursuivant (Arn Hold's Herald) needs an acting herald who might wish to become permanent. Ceridwen, current deputy, has not been consulted as of yet.

Reeve-Arn Hold, as part of the SCA, is a legal charity. Heather successfully obtained corporate charitable donations for the Crown Tourney feast. Crown Tourney finances are still being processed, but it looks like we lost about \$150.00 on the event.

Hospitaller-We have had 10 new people come to our last two events. New copies of "Forward Into the Past" are on order. Mountain Home Air Force Base has agreed to allow general posting of SCA flyers; the Hospitaller will coordinate with PR deputy, seneschale and baron and baroness to design something suitable.

Constable-We had no problems at Crown Tourney, although there were a large number of lost and found items (most claimed by the end of Sunday's tourney). Items still in the lost and found include knee pads, several mugs, a pair of jeans and lots of other good stuff. The Principality Sheriff has no information on warranting or authorization processes for the sheriff-at-large in the constable handbook, and Andrew the Executioner still needs security volunteers for Uprising--but security volunteers must be area constables, deputy constables, or sheriffs-at-large.

Chirurgion-Needed supplies for the chirurgion's box have been priced at a total of \$150.00. Work is now commencing on whittling this amount down to a workable figure. No injuries were reported at Crown Tourney, and the waterbearing was remarked upon as being excellent.

Pegasus-This office was handled for Crown Tourney by Kieren Edana Fraser, who reported finding crash space for all visitors, even those who called Friday night.

List Mistress-Crown Tourney was won by Duke Thorfinn, and Viscount Sir Morgan d'Antioch won the Queen's Champion tourney.

The Chronicler and the Minister of Arts and Sciences were not present.

Thirty Years War

Join Arn Hold for the Thirty Years' War, or, Age and Treachery will overcome Youth and Skill Every Time, to be held at Sawtooth Lodge in Grandjean, Idaho, July 16-17, 1994. Just who is fighting at this war? Well, those over 30 years of age will be fighting those under 30 years of age, with numbers made up on either side by the 30 year olds. Various battle scenarios should be equivalent to those of Raptor War. Combat archers will be fighting as lights. But wait, there's more. Other activities will include a rapier prize tourney, a prize bardic (Filk songs only, please), and a mideastern dance prize competition to help you warm up for the Arn Hold mideastern event in September. The size will open at 6pm July 15 and close at 6pm July 17. Site fees will be \$7.00 with proof of membership, \$8.00 to non members. This is a camping event, and the site is wet. Fires, however, are only allowed in designated fire pits. The hot springs should be in good shape this year, but more information will be available after Raptor War (Memorial Day weekend, same site). 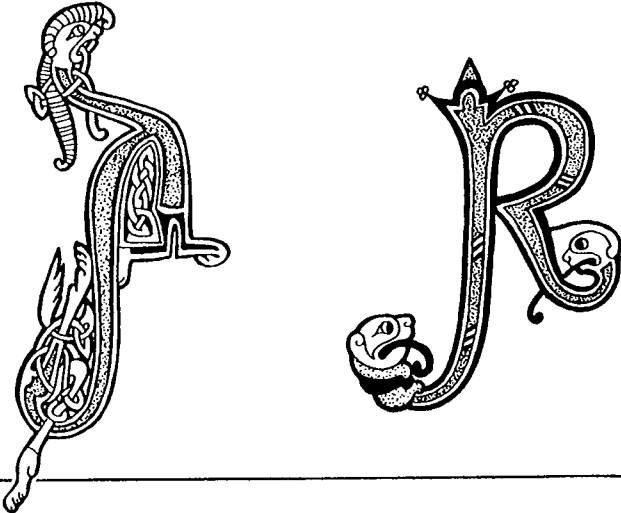

Event Reports:

Crown Tourney-lost about \$150.00 due to small turnout, but feast came in under budget; kingdom exchequer will be contacted to find out how to handle loss.

Attendance was 160, the kingdom fundraiser netted \$10.57, and the Senior Center staff was pleased with us in general and in the way the hall was cleaned after the event.

Raptor War-Kelwyn will be leaving early Friday (about 9 a.m.) to build hot tubs at the site. Anyone interested in helping should contact her.

Thirty Years' War-Scenarios are being crafted, and personal invitations are being sent to out of area gentles we'd like to have attend.

Baron & Baroness' Report

More television coverage from channel 7 may be upcoming, as they have expressed interest in doing a feature story on SCA. The BOD will form an interkingdom council with one representative from each kingdom (plus a mundane business expert and one or more attorneys), each sitting for a two-year term, to provide input from members and to help figure out what the SCA is and where the organization will be going, long-term. His Majesty, Brion, has asked for input on how to choose this representative, and would like to have all opinions by June 1.

The petition from Mountain Home to become a canton contains more than 50% of the paid members as of the February membership census, and so is valid. The next step in the process is for the prospective canton to provide a list of officer, meeting times and places and a list of the territory covered in the canton. The barony, concomitantly, needs to draft a letter of release for the canton. The questions of liability, especially with respect to new BOD directives such as nonmember surcharges or waivers, will be researched and reported on later, but it is known that canton officers have the same responsibilities as shire or baronial officers, but with an extra level of reporting (baronial).

Baron Einendoch will write the demo chapter in the new seneschal's handbook.

The next officers' meeting will be held at Kieren's house (contact seneschale, Baronage or Kieren for directions), June 12 at 5 p.m. There will be a barbecue.

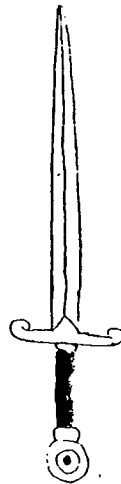
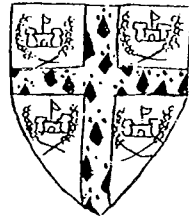
TWAE LINNES PARADE / DEMO

Large gaps in the data exist due to the fact that the MooseCall was not published during the first seven years of the group's existence and the fact that memories aren't often as good as we wish them to be. OFFICE OF THE SENESCHAL

Bearing the badge "Gules, a key fesswise, Or." The Seneschal(e) is one of two required officers every SCA group must have. He (She) is described in the Known World Handbook as "The chief administrative officer and legal representative of any SCA group ... responsible for coordinating the activities of the group's other officers." The role of the Seneschal(e) is very important in the formative years of any group. It is often made more difficult by misunderstandings, social and philosophical differences, and other forms of disagreements between the office and the members of the Populace and/or the presence of a Territorial Baron/Baroness. What authority the office has may be and often is delegated to the Baron and Baroness if invested as a Barony, but the responsibility remains with this, "the legal representative" of the group. Each of the Seneschal(e)s listed below has contributed toward the growth of Arn Hold in their own special way. We are pleased to include them in this Great List.

Chirurgeon's Corner

Camping season is upon us...Raptor War is around the corner, so are...TICKS!!! Ticks are not fussy about what type of animal provides their meal. Humans are fair game to them. Here's what to do when one latches onto you.

Remove the Beast: Ticks pose a special problem because they dig their little jaws into your skin and hold on for dear life. Trying to brush a tick away as you would a fly has no effect. And forcefully plucking it out may leave mouthparts embedded, setting the stage for infection. Here are some gentler methods for loosening a ticks grip.

Ease it Out: Take a pair of tweezers and very slowly pull the tick out. Don't pull too fast, and if you're not having success, you might try applying a little heat to the tick's backside. Blow a match out, and carefully touch the tick with the tip. The heat may encourage it to let go.

Irritate it: A drop of gasoline, kerosene, benzene or alcohol placed on the general region of the tick's head will make it loosen it's grip. But be patient--it may take ten minutes or more to work. (***) Note: these substances should not be used in conjunction with a hot match.)

Suffocate it: Cover the tick with a drop of paraffin or fingernail polish. Either substance will close off the tiny breathing openings on its side and suffocate the tick.

Clean up: Once you have removed the tick, wash the bite with soap and water. Then apply iodine or another antiseptic to guard against infection.

Be vigilant: Although June and July seem to mark the height of tick season, ticks are a danger from early spring until fall. If your spending any time outdoors, especially in wooded or high-grass areas--even grassy dunes-- take the following precautions.

* Discover if there are ticks in the area. Tie a piece of white flannel to a string and drag it through the grass or underbrush. Examine it frequently. If ticks are present, they will cling to the cloth.

* If you are in a tick area, leave as little skin exposed as possible.

* Before going to bed at night, inspect your body for any freeloading ticks. Certain species can be quite small and you may have overlooked them.


