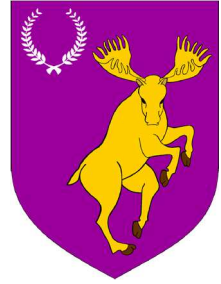

On This Date in History

On August 2, 1343, the Breton knight Olivier de Clisson was executed for treason and other crimes against the French crown, stirring from his involvement in the Breton War of Succession, an early part of what is now known as the Hundred Years' War. This is significant because it led Olivier's wife, 43 year old Jeanne de Clisson, also known as Jeanne de Belleville, the Lion of Brittany, to swear revenge against the French crown.

Jeanne sold her lands and possessions, raised an army, and began attacking French held towns in Brittany, usually leaving one or two survivors to return to their masters and tell the tale of her fury. Jeanne received the support of the English King Edward III, who granted her letters of mark, and she outfitted three warships, supposedly painted black with sails dyed red, known as the Black Fleet. Jeanne spent the next two decades harrying French ships and sending one or two survivors back to France to tell their stories to the King.

In 1356 Jeanne, now in her mid fifties, married Sir Walter Bentley, a loyal supporter of King Edward III who had been awarded for winning the Battle of Mauron with extensive lands and castles on the coasts of Brittany. She died at the castle of Hennebont in 1359.

Dinner will be a sausage-fest! The Arn Hold Cooks Guild is creating several kinds of bratwurst, knockwurst, otherwurst, and mockwurst for those who like animal alternatives. Take the first exit (north) and take Star Rd. 6.3 mi into the town of Star. The site will be on your left just after the stop light in town. There will be signs.

Site opens at 10am for class and A&S setup and will close at 9pm after dinner and dancing.

Family Cap: \$30

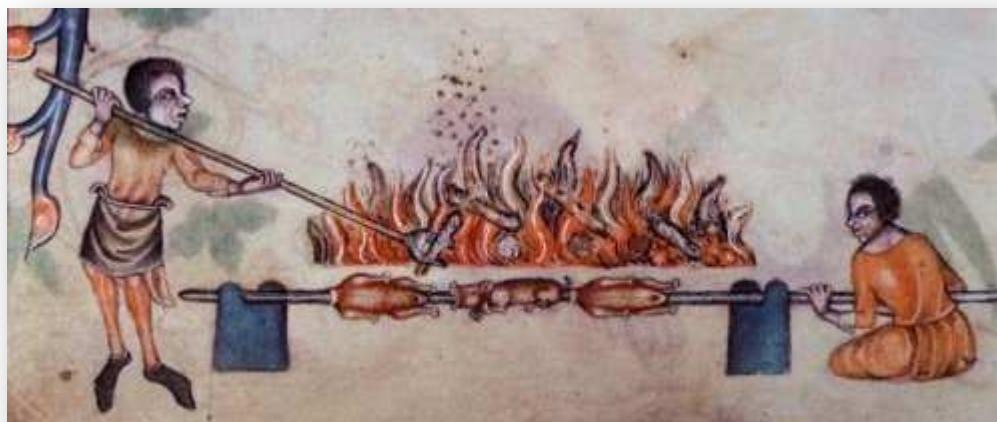
Feast Fee: \$8

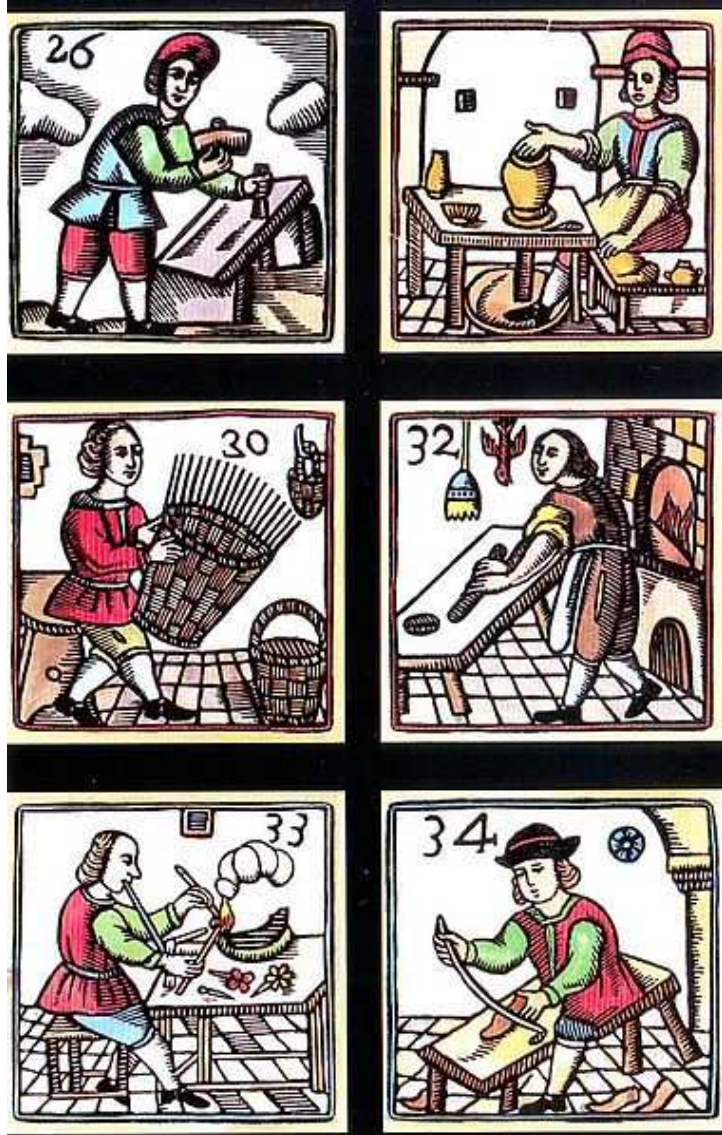

The Legal Bits

The deadline for submission is the 20th of each month for publication by the end of the month. All items submitted to the *Moose Call* for publication must be accompanied by a Release for Publication, except submissions by regular (or semi-regular) columnists. Items submitted will remain the property of the submitter, and will be returned as appropriate. The *Moose Call* reserves the right to publish submissions as space and time allow, and to edit for grammar and content if necessary. Submissions that are original works will be credited appropriately. Submissions that are not original works must credit the source in some fashion. Submissions may be mailed, emailed, or given to *Moose Call* staff. Please see the Officers Listing for mailing and email addresses. Please use the following guidelines when submitting:

Written: Written submissions are transcribed. When submitting, please print on plain white paper using a minimum 12 point plain font. Drawings and hard-copy photos are scanned; please make sure they are as clean and clear as possible. Handwritten submissions are accepted, and should be as legible as possible.

Email: Email submissions can either be contained in the body of the email message, or sent as a file attachment. File attachments should be plain text (.txt), rich text (.rtf) or Word document (.doc or .docx) format for text. Graphics and Photos should be saved as JPEG (.jpg or .jpeg) or PNG (.png) as appropriate.

Photo Policy: It is the responsibility of the photographer submitting photos for publication to obtain releases from the subjects in the photo. By submitting a photo for publication, the submitter affirms that they have and are giving permission to publish the photo, and that they have obtained all necessary releases from the subject(s).
