

Barony of Arn Hold • Parent/Guardian Responsibilities for Children at Events

General Parental Responsibilities

Parents/guardians will know where their children are, be aware of what they are doing at all times, and be responsible for their actions while at our event. If a child is endangering themselves or causing problems, an event steward or the seneschal will approach the parent concerning the problem. This will be done with tact and courtesy, and with the expectation that the parent will promptly address the situation with their own child. Additionally, parents should not expect other adults to supervise, monitor, or otherwise control children who are wandering unaccompanied at our event. Children age 12 and under must be within sight/sound of their responsible parents/guardian at all times. This policy is not subject to variance, nor does it permit pre-existing nonconforming activities. For camping events, children age 14 and under must be with their parents/guardians or in their camp at 10:00 pm. Any child participating in Archery must have one parent/guardian present on the range at all times.

Neglect of Parental (or Guardian) Responsibility For Minors

If event/Branch/SCA officials find minor(s) in breach of the site rules, they will (for first offense) escort the minor(s) to their parents/guardians and issue a verbal warning. A report on the incident will be tendered to the Kingdom Seneschal. On a second offense at the same event, the parents/guardian will be required to keep their minor(s) with them for the remainder of the event. A report on the incident will be tendered to the Kingdom and Society Seneschals. On the third offense, the minor(s) and their parents/guardian will be expelled from the event, and the matter will be reported to the Kingdom and Society Seneschals.

Habitual offenders will be subject to review by Kingdom and Society level for possible sanctions.
